AIRPORT & COMMUNITY OFFICIALS HOLD PRE-HOLIDAY TRAVEL BRIEFING

Savings, services and fun take the 'bah humbug!' out of holiday travel

SAN FRANCISCO -- Representatives of San Francisco International Airport and the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) will conduct an Airport press briefing Thursday, December 11, at 11:00 a.m. in the International Terminal, between ticket islands 6 and 7.

Along with holiday travel tips, recommended arrival times and public transportation and parking options, the Airport will provide an update on holiday air travel statistics and announce the expansion of the current in-airport and radio holiday promotion, "Holidays Take-off at SFO."

SFO wants to remind travelers that the TSA recommends that packages not be gift wrapped prior to passing through one of the Airport's security checkpoints. As a service to our travelers, the Airport is joining with the Big Brothers/Big Sisters of San Francisco and the Peninsula and the Hamilton Family Center to provide complimentary gift-wrapping at key locations beyond the security checkpoints during peak travel times. No other airport in Bay Area, and probably the nation, will be offering its travelers this type of customer service.

Joining Airport representatives will be Sherry Squire Mitchell, Executive Director of Big Brothers/Big Sisters of San Francisco and the Peninsula; and Suzie Sheedy, Development Director of the Hamilton Family Center in San Francisco.

The Mission Dolores Choir & Dance Troupe will perform at the press briefing.
