**CONCESSION OPPORTUNITY AT  
SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

**SAN FRANCISCO** -- San Francisco International Airport will accept proposals for the Terminal 3 Newsstands Lease (“**Lease**”), a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Set-Aside. The deadline to submit a proposal is at 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, May 26, 2004.

Per the Request for Proposal (“**RFP**”) Document and Addendum, the proposer must submit a proposal demonstrating that the minimum qualifications are satisfied, its proposal, and its deposit to ensure that the proposer will sign the Lease should the proposer be awarded the Lease. The Lease is for a term of five years with five one-year options. The rent is set at the minimum annual guarantee or the tiered percentage rent, whichever is greater. The minimum acceptable proposal amount is \$230,000. The Lease comprises two facilities, which totals approximately 805 square feet, in Terminal 3. The Airport Commission will award the Lease to the best responsive and responsible proposer.
